# Clinical Significance of Vamana and Virechana Karma in Kapha & Pitta Vyadhi: A Review

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#### **Abstract**

The most crucial aspect of Ayurveda treatments is *Panchakarma* that works to prevent and treat diseases. It also promotes and preserves general health, considered as worthful therapy due to its adequacy. This therapy involves five procedures which utilizes for various purposes. *Virechana* and *Vamana Karma* are important therapies of *Panchakarma* amongst the five therapeutic measures. These therapies mainly employed for the management of diseases of *Kapha* and *Pitta* vitiation. The drugs used for *Virechana* and *Vamana Karma* offers *Tikshna*, *Sukshma* and *Ushna* properties thus pacifies morbid *Pitta*, *Kapha*, and *Vata doshas*, also facilitate removal of toxins from the body. These two therapies utilize for managing many diseases under the heading of *Shodhana Chikitsa*. Present article reviewed the role of *Virechana* and *Vamana Karma* in *Kapha* and *Pitta Vyadhi* respectively.

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#### 1. Introduction

The science of life and longevity is Ayurveda. Ayurveda suggested various therapeutic measures for disease management, these measures includes some purification approaches like *Vamana* and *Virechana Karma* which gives relief in many diseases. These purification measures of Ayurveda come under the heading of *Panchakarma* that eliminates morbid *Doshas, Malas* and clears *Srotas*. The various *Aushadha* used in *Panchakarma* therapy facilitate detoxification process by virtue of their specific properties. (1-5)

Ayurveda aims to treat disease and maintain health in healthy individuals. Diet and lifestyle changes like the *Ritucharya*, *Dincharya*, *Abhayanga*, *Dhupana* and *Nasya* can help to achieve the objective of Ayurveda. Detoxification procedures described by ancient Ayurvedic sages like *Vamana*, *Basti*, *Nasya*, *Virechan*, *Swedana* and *Snehana*, etc. can helps to prevent and treat disease pathogenesis.

Vitiation of *Doshas* produces *Doshavaishamya* which ultimately affects *Srotasa* of the body and block them

leading to the pathological manifestation. These *Srotasa* needs to be cleared for keeping up balance of *Doshas* and to maintain wellbeing. *Panchakarma* therapy works in this regards, it is a great and excellent way to treat illness and maintain the body's full strength. *Panchakarma* procedures are distinguished by their capacity for clearing body channels, it eliminate toxins and resist pathogenesis of many diseases. *Panchakarma* therapy is a systematized version of *Samshodhana* therapy that incorporates every method of purification. *Vamana* and *Virechana Karma* are two important methods of *Panchakarma* therapy which prevents or treats diseases mainly associated with *Kapha & Pitta* vitiation. #### 2. Vamana Therapy




Figure 1. General Properties of Vamana Aushdhi

Vamana is one of the Panchakarma systems, in order to purify the body this therapy induce vomiting to eliminate all vitiated Doshas from the stomach. Kapha vitiation typically can be cured by the Vamana procedure. The general properties of Vamana Aushdhi are depicted in **Figure 1**.

Ayurveda described two types of *Vamana* drugs i.e. *Vamaka* drugs and *Vamanopaga* drugs. *Vamaka* drugs make patient to vomit. These drugs are hot and sharp in nature, and entering throughout the body. Liquorice and *Vacha* are comes under this category. *Vamanopaga* drugs are spices which include *Pippali*, *Madana Phal* and *Amalaki* etc.

#### Vamana therapy for Kapha Roga:

Vaman's primary goal is to eliminate extra and vitiated Kapha. Vaman, along with Kapha, helps to balance Pitta Dosha. This is one of the pieces of the Shodhana treatment, which eliminate vitiated Doshas and toxins from the body. Vamana Dravyas are having the properties Vyavayi and Vikasi, by prudence of Veerya they get rapidly flow into the little vessels of the body. At the cellular level, the accumulated Doshas become liquified and break up into small pieces due to the Ushna and Tikshna properties of Vamana drugs. It removes the Malas from the Dhatus with the help of its Vikasi Guna. Sukshma Guna facilitates transportation of Vamana drugs and Malarupi Kapha eliminates through the stomach and respiratory tract.

Vamana Karma is extremist treatment to treat the pathology by eliminating illness causative element Kapha from its primary site of gathering. Vamana scrubs the various kinds of poisonous materials from the body. The mobilization of the Dosha from Shakha to Koshta is made easier by all the preparatory measures of Vamana Karma.

Vamana was actuated in the early morning as this is considered Kapha Kala. Madanaphalapippali, Vacha, Saindhava Lavana and others drugs used for Vamana Karma. Vamaka drugs have characteristics such as Ushna, Tikshna, Sukshma and Vyavayi. The effectiveness of these medicines is determined by their potency. Vamana drugs spread all through the body channels and toxins are broken up by these medicines. These Vamana drugs cause toxins to be eliminated from the Kostha and respiratory passage. The vitiated Kapha mainly accumulates at these sites and Vamana removes morbidity from these two places therefore offers therapeutic benefits in Kapha Vyadhi. (6-9)

## 3. Virechna Therapy

Virechana is a form of internal detoxification that uses induced and controlled movements of faces to cleanse the body. In order to cleanse the body and prevent diseases caused by Pitta Dosha, Virechana therapy can be recommended.

Pachana medicines are initially administered, after that, Swedana and Sarvanga are practiced for few days. After Sarvanga Snehana and Swedana, Virechaka drugs are given which begins the purging of body by inducing defecation. Virechana is for the most part encouraged to patients having skin issues, hyperacidity and Pittaja Vyadhi, etc.

#### Virechana therapy for Pittaja Vyadhi:

Virechana Dravyas works by virtue of their Ushna, Tikshna, Sukshma, Vyavayi and Vikasi properties. Ushna Guna possesses Agneya property, it makes easier for morbid Doshas to move toward the Kostha.

Tikshna property of Virechana Dravya carries out the role of Sanghatabhedana; which refers to the breaking down of morbidly complex into smaller molecules. This helps in rapid excretion of morbidity. Hence, Tikshna property breaks the Mala and vitiated Dosha in miniature structure which further prompting removal of toxins from the body.

Anupravanabhava effect of Virechana Dravyas enables the drug to enter into the micro-channel and dilate the channel. This property enables the morbid matter to be brought to Kostha for expulsion and helps to remove it from the micro-channels.

Vyavayi Guna of Virechana Dravyas causes drugs to spread quickly throughout the body and begin to work before they get digested. Virechaka drugs spread throughout the body without changing form and eliminates accumulated Kapha from the lower parts of the body.

Vikasi Guna of Virechana Dravyas enables drugs to start working without being broken down. Doshas are driven to the Kostha by virtue of all of these properties. Virechana drugs reach the micro-channels because of

their *Vikasi*, *Vyavayi* and *Sukshma Gunas*. At the site of action these drugs eliminates vitiated *Pitta Dosha*.

Virechana drugs scrape out liquefy morbid Mala and Doshas by virtue of their Ushna and Tikshna Gunas. Shakhagat Mala or impurities are brought to Koshtha by Virechana drugs, where they are expelled out from the body.

Virechaka drugs perform Virechana because of the drug's Prabhava or Achintya Virya. Virechaka drugs having Jala and Pruthvi Mahabhutas dominancy thus having ability to go downwards and in this manner they can help in the process of purgation. The Virechana Karma also depends upon the Virechaka Prabhava of drugs which is considered as inherent property of Ayurveda medicine. The Virya, Prabhava and Guna of drugs help them to perform their Virechana Karma to cure Pitta Vyadhi. (9-12)

#### 4. Conclusion

Vamana therapy plays a significant role in both symptomatic and root-cause treatment of Kapha Vyadhi. Panchakarma treatments are an important part of the Ayurvedic treatment system because they purify the body and are useful for managing certain chronic and lifestyle disorders. Shodhana Chikitsa works with the ejection of vitiated *Doshas* from the body, there by fixes the illness from root, in this way Shodhana Chikitsa can forestall the repeated prevalence of disease in future. Virechana and Vamana Karma are employed for the management of diseases of Kapha and Pitta vitiation. The drugs used for Virechana and Vamana Karma having Tikshna, Sukshma and Ushna properties; these properties helps in the expulsion of morbid Doshas. Vamana and Virechana Dravyas relieve symptoms of Kapha & Pitta Vyadhis by virtue of their Vikasi, Vyavayi, Sukshma, Ushna and Tikshna Gunas.
